TRAFFIC ROUND-UP FOR 2018

Having increased by 13.2 per cent over 2017 to reach an unprecedented 6.8 million movements, passenger traffic for 2018 registered its ninth year of uninterrupted growth at Malta International Airport. According to Airports Council International's (ACI) annual traffic report, Malta International Airport's double-digit growth outperformed the growth rate of 6.5 per cent recorded by airports in its group; each one hosting between five and 10 million passengers annually.

While the peak summer months grew by 12.2 per cent, passenger traffic during the shoulder and winter months increased by 14.0 per cent in line with the airport's and the main tourism stakeholders' joint strategy of promoting the Maltese islands as a year-round destination to mitigate seasonality. In fact, the months delivering the highest percentage growth rates for 2018 were March (22.6 per cent), February (18.0 per cent) and May (17.3 per cent).

The top drivers of passenger traffic in 2018 were the United Kingdom (+13.4 per cent), Italy (+14.1 per cent), Germany (+2.0 per cent), France (+14.5 per cent), and Spain (+37.8 per cent). All of these markets registered an improvement in passenger movements over the previous year, but at 37.8 per cent, Spain's growth rate was the most substantial. This stemmed from enhanced connections with the Spanish market, including new routes to Bilbao, Seville and Malaga, and better flight frequencies operated on a number of existing routes.

2018 REVENUES

At the start of 2019, Malta International Airport announced that its profits for the year ended on the 31st of December 2018 had increased from €24.2 million to €30.3 million, translating into a growth of 25.6 per cent over 2017.

Both the company's aviation and non-aviation revenues registered an increase when compared to the previous year, driving the Group's total revenues up 11.9 per cent to total €92.2 million. Aviation revenues, which were up 11.1 per cent to total €65.5 million, can be largely attributed to an increase of 13.2 per cent in traffic, which reached a new all-time high of 6,808,177 passenger movements in 2018.

With an increase of 14.1 per cent to reach €26.7 million, the Company's non-aviation activities also delivered positive results, in line with its corporate strategy. A positive trend was registered across most of the revenue streams within the retail and property portfolio, with particularly noteworthy contributions from the airport's retail outlets and SkyParks Business Centre. Within this portfolio, the Company's VIP products registered the biggest increase over 2017 (+36.3 per cent).

The Earnings before Interest, Taxation, Depreciation and Amortisation (EBITDA) of the Group increased from €48.6 million to €54.4 million.

A LOOK AT 2019

FURTHER GROWTH EXPECTED IN 2019

As is customary, the company started off the year by publishing its traffic forecast for 2019, announcing that it was expecting further growth to reach 7.2 million passenger movements. Although the increase of approximately 6 per cent forecast for 2019 constitutes a slower growth rate than has been experienced in the past years, it is natural to see traffic start to plateau following 9 years of robust growth.

Cumulatively, the first two months of the year saw 725,410 passengers pass through Malta International Airport. While January's increase in passenger movements was that of 4.1 per cent, registered in parallel with a 7.9 per cent growth in seat capacity, February traffic grew by 2.9 per cent alongside an improvement of 6.4 per cent in seat capacity.

In February, the United Kingdom moved back to the top of the list of Malta International Airport's main drivers of passenger traffic, after having dropped a place in January. While Malta International Airport's top three markets – the United Kingdom, Italy and Germany – lost passenger movements in both January and February when compared with 2017, France and Spain experienced a noteworthy increase in traffic in January and continued the growth trend into February.

The performance of the Spanish and French markets indicates that the joint traffic diversification strategy of Malta International Airport, the Ministry for Tourism and the Malta Tourism Authority is bearing the desired results, in that it has stimulated newer markets to gain momentum just as legacy markets such as the United Kingdom, Italy and Germany are reaching maturity.

INVESTMENTS IN THE COMING YEARS

With a capex plan for the year that is estimated to reach over €20 million, 2019 is set to be an important year for Malta International Airport in terms of investment in the whole airport campus.

• THE PARKING VILLAGE

Malta International Airport's €20-million parking village project is on track to be completed by 2020. This parking area will introduce 1,300 covered parking spaces on the airport campus for the benefit of passengers, visitors and employees, as well as provide car rental companies with a more centralised area of operation.

• SKYPARKS 2

Having issued a call for tenders for the design concept of SkyParks 2 earlier this year, the company envisages to have in hand detailed plans for this project by the end of 2019. Subject to Board approval, the multi-purpose building is set to introduce 22,000 square metres of office and commercial space as well as the first business hotel in the airport's neighbourhood.

• THE TERMINAL EXPANSION PROJECT

With its €12-million Terminal Reconfiguration Project now completed, Malta International Airport will shift its focus on securing plans for a terminal expansion. This multi-million-euro project will see the terminal building occupy a much larger footprint and offer enhanced facilities, which will better poised the airport to deliver the 5-star service it places so much importance upon.

• THE DEVELOPMENT OF APRON X

Complementing this terminal investment, will be the development of Apron X. The company will be working on detailed plans for the development of this new aircraft parking stand throughout 2019. Located in the midst of the operational hub, Apron X will provide seven additional stands for Code C aircraft or four stands for Code E aircraft, furnishing the airport with aircraft capacity stability for the long term. •

Žieda ta' 13.2% fuq l-2017 wasslet it-traffiku tal-ajrupoport sabiex jilhaq is-6.8 miljun moviment tal-passiġġieri fl-ahhar tas-sena 2018. Din is-sena kienet ukoll id-disa' sena li fiha giet irregjistrata žieda fil-movimenti tal-passiġġieri. Skont ir-rapport annwali tat-traffiku ta' Airports Council International (ACI) din ir-rata ta' tkabbir tal-Ajruport Internazzjonali ta' Malta sebqet ir-rata ta' tkabbir ta' 6.5% irregjistrata mill-ajrupoporti tad-daqi tiegħi; jiġifieri li jilqghu bejn hames u 10 miljun passiġġier kull sena.

Filwaqt li fl-eqqel xhur tas-sajf it-traffiku ždied bi 12.2%, in-numru ta' passiġġieri li ghaddew mill- Ajruport Internazzjonali ta' Malta fix-xhur tax-xitwa esperjenza tkabbir ta' 14.0%. Din il-prestazzjoni tawgura tajjeb ghall-istreġjja konġunta tal-ajrupoport u tal-partijiet interessaati ewlenin fl-industria tat-turiżmu li tippromwovi lil Malta bħala destinazzjoni ideali tul is-sena kollha u b'hekk tiġi

indirizzata l-istajgħonalità. Fil-fatt, ix-xhur li kibru bl-aktar ritmu mghażżeġ tul-l-2018 kienu Marzu (22.6%), Frar (18.0%) u Mejju (17.3%).

L-aqwa hamest iswieq tal-ajrupoport ghall-2018 kienu r-Renju Unit (+13.4%), l-Italja (+14.1%), il-Ğermanja (+2.0%), Franzia (+14.5%) u Spanja (+37.8%). 


Kemm id-dhul mis-segment tal-avjazzjoni kif ukoll dak mis-segment tal-bejgh u l-proprietà rregħistaw żidet fuq is-sena preċedenti, li rriżultaw fi tkabbir ta' 11.9% fid-dhul totali tal-Grupp, li lahaq total ta' €92.2 miljuni. Id-dhul mis-segment tal-avjazzjoni żdied bi 11.1% biex lahaq €65.5 miljun. Tkabbir ta' 13.2% fit-traffiku wassal għal din iż-żieda fid-dhul, hekk kif ghall-ewwel darba gew irregjistrati 6,808,177 moviment tal-passiġġieri fl-2018.

F'konformità mal-istratx-ġiġi korporattiva tal-kumpañija, l-attivitàjet relatati mal-bejgh u l-proprietà wkoll taw riżultati pozittivi hekk kif id-dhul minn dan is-segment żdied bi 14.1% biex lahaq €26.7 miljun. INTO THE DEEP WITH THE PHOENICIAN SHIPWRECK EXCAVATION

A project that is currently being supported by the Malta Airport Foundation is the ongoing excavation of a Phoenician shipwreck just off Xlendi Bay in Gozo. Dating back to the 7th century BC, the wreck was discovered in 2007 and is just the eighth archaic Phoenician shipwreck to be located.

The ship itself has very likely been partially eroded, but the mixed cargo on board, including Tyrrhenian amphorae, urns and Gozitan ceramics, was the first of its kind to be found intact. The discovery of this cargo reinforces the argument that the Maltese islands were an important part of the Phoenician maritime and trading network.

Hailing from all corners of the world and led by a local maritime archaeologist, a team of highly technical divers is gradually recovering these artefacts. Some of these artefacts were put on exhibition at the Gozo Museum of Archaeology in September 2018 for the appreciation of both locals and tourists, serving to heighten awareness of our underwater heritage.

RESEARCH ON THE TRIPTYCH OF THE MADONNA DEL SOCCORSO

In line with its pledge to safeguard Malta's artistic heritage, the Malta Airport Foundation is currently financing research work being conducted by the University of Malta on the Triptych of the Madonna del Soccorso. The works include an in-depth analysis of the wood and pigments used as well as 3D scanning, making this work of art the first one on the islands to be analysed using this method.

Dating back to the 15th century, and being attributed to Antonio de Saliba, the triptych serves as another confirmation that the island had its own refined works of art even before the Knights of the Order of St John arrived in Malta. The Triptych of the Madonna del Soccorso forms part of the Mdina Cathedral Museum collection, with this museum being home to an impressive series of artworks and artefacts.



L-ISKAVAR TA' SIT TAHT IL-BAHAR B'IMPORTANZA ARKEOLOGIKA

Projett li qed jiġi appoġġjat mill-Malta Airport Foundation bhalissa, huwa l-iskavar li ilu għaddej għal bosta snin ta' sit fejn instab vapur mgharraq ta' zmien il-Feniċi. L-iskoperta ta' dan il-vapur mgharraq, li jmur lura għas-seba' seklu QK, saret fl-2007, b'dan il-vapur ikun biss it-tmien vapur mgharraq akajku ta' zmien il-Feniċi.

Luu tassew probabbli li l-vapur innifus tmermer parżjalment, iżda t-taghbija mhallta li kienet abbord, u li kienet tinkludi anfori Tirreni, urni u xogħlijiet tač-ċeramika mill-għira Ghawdexja, kienet l-ewwel tax-xorta tagħha li nistebt intatta. L-iskoperta ta' din it-taghbija tkompli ssahħħah l-argument li l-gżejjjer Maltin kienu parti importanti min-netwrx marittimu u kummerċjali tal-Feniċi.

L-oġgetti li jinsabu abbord dan il-vapur qed jittellgħu fuq l-art gradwalment minn tim ta' ghaddasa teknici li ġejjin minn madwar id-dinja u li huma mmexxija minn arkeologu marittimu Malti. Uhud minn dawn l-oġġetti tqiegħdu fil-Mużew tal-Arkeoloġija f'Għawdex f'Settembru 2018 sabiex jiġu apprezzati mill-publiku lokali u t-turisti, u b'hekk jitqajjem għarriefi akbar dwar il-wirt tagħna ta' taht il-bahar.

RIČERKA DWAR IT-TRITTINU TAL-MADONNA TAS-SOKKORS

F'konformità mal-impenn tagħha sabiex thares ukoll il-wirt artistiku ta' Malta, il-Malta Airport Foundation bhalissa qed tagħti l-appoġġ tagħha lill-Universitāt ta' Malta sabiex twettaq riċerka dwar Trittku tal-Madonna tas-Sokkors. Ix-xogħlijiet ta' riċerka jinkludu analizi bir-reqqu tal-injam u ż-żebha użati permezz ta' skennjar bit-3D, li jagħmlu dan ix-xogħol artistiku l-ewwel wieħed li qed jiġi analizzat b'dan il-metodu f'Malta.

It-trittku jmur lura għas-seklu ħmistax u huwa attribwiit lil Antonio de Saliba. Dan ix-xogħol artistiku jkompli jikkonferma li l-gżejjjer kelhom xogħlijiet ta' arti mill-aqwa anki qabel il-wasla tal-Kavallieri tal-Ordn ta' San Gwann f'Malta. It-Trittiku tal-Madonna tas-Sokkors jidher ja' minn mill-kolleżzjoni tal-Mużew tal-Katidral tal-Imdina, li huwa magħruf għall-kolleżzjonijiet ta' arti u oġġetti prezjużi oħrajn esibiti fihi.

CLEANER SEAS

WITH THE SEA BIN PROJECT

In 2018, the Malta Airport Foundation partnered up with eNGO Żibel to support the procurement of two sea bins. Guided by its commitment to invest in the airport's neighbourhood, the Malta Airport Foundation sponsored sea bins which will be installed in Marsaxlokk and Marsascala.

Sea bins contribute to cleaner waters by catching waste such as microplastics and marine debris, and also have the potential to collect a percentage of oils and pollutants floating on the sea surface. The two most common items that are caught by these bins are cigarette butts and plastic particles; items that would pose a hazard to marine eco-systems as well as blight our beautiful seas if left uncollected. •



IBHRA INDAF BIL-PROġETT TAS-SEA BINS




SHARE PERFORMANCE ANALYSIS

Malta International Airport's share price has been breaking new highs in the past few months. On 24 September 2018, MIA reached the €6.00 level for the first time and subsequently climbed further to reach the €6.30 level by mid-November. During the final weeks of 2018, the equity of MIA eased back to the €5.80 level. Nonetheless, this still represented an uplift of 23.4% for the whole of 2018 with the equity ranking as the second-best performer for the year in the local equity market.

Demand for MIA shares rebounded at the start of 2019 as the equity recaptured the €6.30 level by the end of January 2019 on the back of yet another record year in terms of passenger numbers as well as expectations of an increase of around 6% in 2019 to reach 7.2 million passenger movements. Similarly, the equity continued to trend higher in February as it closed the second month of 2019 at a new record high of €6.50 representing a year-to-date uplift of just over 12.0%. As a result, MIA is once again one of the best-performing equities in the local market with the MSE Equity Indices returning just 0.2% during the first two months of this year.



ANALIZI TAL-PRESTAZZJONI TAL-ISHPMA

F'dawn l-ahhar xhur, il-prezz tal-ishma tal-MIA lahaq quċċati ġodda. Fl-24 ta' Settembru 2018, l-ishma tal-MIA laħqu l-livell ta' €6.00 ghall-ewwel darba, u komplew telgħin sakemm laħqu l-livell ta' €6.30 f'nofs Novembru. Matul l-ahhar gimħat tal-2018, il-prezz tal-ishma tal-MIA nizel lura għal-livell ta' €5.80. Madankollu, dan ir-rizultat xorta waħda rrifletta żieda ta' 23.4% fuq is-sena ta' qabel, u b'hekk wassal sabiex l-ishma jkollhom it-tieni l-aqwa prestazzjoni għall-2018 fi ħdan is-suq lokali tal-ishma.

Id-domanda għall-ishma tal-MIA ir-kuprat fil-bidu tal-2019, hekk kif l-ishma reġġhu telgħu għal-livell ta' €6.30 sal-ahħar ta' Jannar 2019. Dan wara sena rekord oħra f'dak li għandu xjaqsam ma' movimenti ta' passiġġieri, u t-tbassir li l-ghadd ta' passiġġieri li se jilqa' l-ajrport misterni jiżid b'madwar 6% fl-2019, biex jilhaq 7.2 miljun movimenti tal-passiġġieri. Bl-istess mod, ix-xejra ta' tkabbi kompliet matul it-tieni xahar tas-sena, hekk kif Frar għalaq b'ishma rekord ta' €6.50 għall-MIA; valur li żid b'iċtar minn 12.0% mill-bidu tas-sena. Dan it-tkabbir wassal biex, għal-darba oħra, l-ishma tal-MIA jitqiesu bħala whud mill-aktar isħma b'sahħithom fis-suq lokali, hekk kif l-Indiċi Azzjonarji tal-MSE kisbu redditu ta' 0.2% biss matul l-ewwel xahrejn ta' din is-sena.

Iż-żieda fil-prezz tal-ishma f'dawn l-ahħar gimħat ġie sostnun ukoll mill-prestazzjoni finanzjarja rekord tal-kumpanija kif ukoll żieda fid-dividend rakkomandat għas-sena finanzjarja li ntemmet fil-31 ta' Dicembru 2018. Fl-20 ta' Frar 2019, il-bord tad-diretturi tal-kumpanija rrakkomanda distribuzzjoni ta' dividend finali nett ta' €0.09 għal kull sehem, li jirrappreżenta żieda ta' 28.6% fuq is-sena preċedenti. Suġġett għal-approvazzjoni waqt il-Lagħha Generali Annwali tal-kumpanija, skedata għall-15 ta' Mejju 2019, id-divend se jithallas lill-azzjonisti tal-kumpanija sad-29 ta' Mejju.
